Deborah Munroe Noonan Memorial Fund, Bank of America, N.A., Trustee Awards BCA a \$50,000 Multi Year Grant

BOSTON, MA — Boston Center for the Arts (BCA) is delighted to be a recipient of a \$50,000 Multi-Year Discretionary Grant (\$25,000 a year for two years) awarded by Deborah Munroe Noonan Memorial Fund, Bank of America, N.A., Trustee. The grant is part of the Fund's Arts and Culture portfolio, and marks the seventh consecutive year BCA has received this award. BCA is incredibly grateful for Deborah Munroe Noonan Memorial Fund's long-standing support of BCA that allows us to help further direct resources to Boston-area artists.

BCA is where Boston artists create.
